Now, to pay for capitalism's crisis, we have been pushed back further, suffering disproportionately from cuts to jobs, health and welfare. We face attacks on our reproductive rights, our sexual freedom, and attacks on our bodies through domestic and sexual violence. It's the same, and worse, for women the world over, hit by poverty, climate crisis and religious fundamentalism.
